The Enrichment/ Challenge period is a time for students to branch out and develop academic interest or discover a hidden talent. The selection process is actually an interest inventory. Several classes do not run every semester or on both an A and B day. Some classes may not even be scheduled due to low student interest; therefore, it is important to write down six possible choices. If the computer cannot fit one of your choices into your schedule it will pick a class for you. Challenge classes are not a guarantee. If you choose a challenge course you must still write down six possible enrichment choices. If you are selected for a challenge or pre-teaching class, the challenge or pre-teaching class will be scheduled over an enrichment class. Most of the classes are chosen at random by the computer. Students have the ability to be placed in a minimum of two classes and a maximum of four classes depending on the courses scheduled. Below are some things to keep in mind:

- Carefully read the enrichment course descriptions.
- Write down 6 choices.
- **DO NOT** write down a course more than one time!
- If you do not select enough courses you will be assigned courses based on availability.
- Choose carefully, changes **WILL NOT** be made once the scheduling process is complete.
- We will make every effort to honor your requests but please note, due to a variety of circumstances all choices may not be available.
